

SALE OF 1500 M.T. OF FLY ASH

In terms of the order dated 12th August, 2013 passed by the Hon'ble Justice Patherya in G.A.No. 2191 of 2013 with C.S. No. 408 of 2012 (**Leonard Export – Vs- Central Inland Water Transport Corporation Ltd.**) sealed bids are invited from interested persons/firms for 1500 M.T. of bagged fly ash of Thermal Power plant lying at barges, namely D.B. Goriganga and D.B. Kaveri presently docked at Princep Mooring and No. 8 Mooring of Kolkata Port Trust, on River Hooghly on "as is where is whatever there is basis". The successful bidder will place its vessel alongside the barges mentioned hereinabove and can arrange unloading of the bagged fly ash to its vessels at their cost and responsibility. Otherwise, the CIWTC can place both the barges at Jetty No.1 of T.T.Sheds at 6, Garden Reach Road, Kolkata – 700043 with the permission of the Kolkata Port Trust for discharge of bagged fly ash from the vessel to the vehicle of the successful bidder. It is, however, made clear that the charges of the Kolkata Port Trust shall be paid by the successful bidder including unloading charges. Interested parties may contact Commercial Department, RSD of CIWTC Ltd., 6, Garden Reach Road, Kolkata – 700043 for inspection of the vessels. The bidders should place their bid in a sealed envelope along with an earnest money of Rs.10000 in the form of a draft/pay order in favour of Chayan Gupta, the receiver appointed by the order dated 12.8.2013 passed by Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta. The earnest money shall however be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders without interest. Bids shall be received upto 3 pm on 01.10.2013 and shall be opened on 01.10.2013 at 4-30 pm by the receiver in the Bar Library Club, High Court, Calcutta in the presence of the intending bidders.
